What are the options?



In-School

Students attend their home school following the schedule set out by the Hawkins County School System. Depending on numbers, this could be in-person, hybrid, or all virtual.

Hawkins County eLearning (HCeL)

Hawkins County eLearning (HCeL) is a continuation of the Hawkins County Schools curriculum of study for enrolled HCS students. This program requires students to sign in daily to a virtual setting for instruction and discussions. Students will complete assignments online. When remote learners return to the face-to-face classroom, HCS expects a seamless transition for students returning to traditional instruction. Students can apply for HCeL, and if accepted, must complete at least one semester before returning to an in-school option.



Virtual Academy

The HCVA targets non-traditional learners and current homeschool students wanting to enroll in the free Hawkins County Schools program. Students are enrolled in completely online coursework. This program will be academically challenging and geared for students who do well with independent learning and seize the opportunity to have a flexible schedule. It is important to note, this is not a "work at your own pace" program as assignments will have start and end dates.
