A common theme during the third marking period was community service and engagement. The first community event was the Veterans Day ceremony. The FCCLA and FFA chapters joined together to recognize and celebrate veterans in the community. Odem alumni and OEISD employee Coach Joey Torres was the keynote speaker for the ceremony.

The district also hosted the second annual feast of kindness which invited students, staff, parents, and everyone in the Odem and Edroy communities to pick up a Thanksgiving meal. The pandemic could not stop the Owls from finding creative ways to continue this heart-warming tradition. Instead of hosting the meal in the cafeteria, the district offered curbside meal pick up, and served over 1,500 Thanksgiving plates. Community members, district staff, and students volunteered to set-up, serve, and clean up for the event, and the OEISD cafeteria staff prepared a delicious meal.

Other community service events from the six weeks included the OEISD canned food drive. The service project brought in over 4,571 food items. The food was donated to the First Baptist Church of Odem.
