

Notice to All Parents/Guardians and Students

We hope that everyone is staying healthy and safe during this difficult time. We continue to monitor the COVID-19 data every day and week by week to make decisions for our schools and as we plan to open the CCHS Dormitory. Dormitory residents will be admitted based on several factors, which includes but is not limited to grade classification (see Re-Opening Plan on Choctaw Tribal Schools website). Each week the COVID-19 health data changes and with careful consideration of the Choctaw Tribal Schools, we will re-open the Dormitory to students that are interested in enrolling at the Choctaw Central Dormitory. A limited number of students, will be allowed to enroll based on COVID-19 Safety Procedures. All enrolled Dormitory students MAY be required to be vaccinated against COVID-19. If this requirement is mandated, you will be notified in advance and be given a timeline for compliance. All Enrolled Dormitory Students must be enrolled as a student at Choctaw Central Middle School/Choctaw Central High School.

Due to the COVID-19 virus, there will be some new changes to the protocols and procedures in the Dormitory for the 2021-2022 school year:

- As the Dormitory is a residential/home-like setting and the students will be in close proximity to each other at times, as well as the staff, it MAY be required that all Enrolled Dormitory students be fully vaccinated prior to checking in. Students would need to have received both shots to be considered fully vaccinated. IF the vaccine is required for eligible students, the parent/legal guardian will be notified immediately to determine if the parent still wants to the student to live in the Dormitory if they do not already have the vaccine.
- Also, we will be using a “fogger” to clean/sanitize the rooms once a week once the student(s) have returned home. This will be for the safety and wellness of our students so that their room will be clean upon their return. Also, this is done in addition to our regular cleaning schedule.
- Any student who is absent for five (5) consecutive days without an excuse will be dropped. The student will then be placed on a waiting list to get back into the Dormitory once a room becomes available. This is so that the now “open” room can be used by another student that wants to come into the Dormitory.
- The Dormitory Program is requiring that a parent/legal guardian/an adult that is 21 years of age or older MUST accompany the student into the building in order to complete a COVID-19 Health Screening Student Form EACH time the student check in.
