Job Description: The duties include, but are not limited to:

- Painting buildings, fixtures, and fixtures
- Spread canvas or cloth over surfaces and objects to prevent paint splattering
- Removes old paint and varnish by scraping, burning, sand blasting, pressure washing, and other methods
- Prepares surface to be painted
- Applies paint, varnished, lacquers, and enamels to interior and exterior surfaces of furniture, wood and metal with brush, paint roller, spray gun or other approved methods of application suitable to surface
- Applies waterproofing to surface when required
- Paints signs and lines on parking lots, sidewalks, and in school gyms
- Cleans and maintains brushes, spray guns, and other equipment used in craft
- Estimates time and materials needed
- Maintains accurate and timely records of time, labor, and materials via computer-based programs
- Establishes and maintains effective working relationships with the supervisor, foreman, and other employees
- Complete work assignments without close supervision
- Completes all projects as to neatness conformance with standards or related trade.
