Daily Pandemic Protocol

2020-2021 School Year

Step by Step Instructions

1. Students should not arrive before 8 a.m.
2. Students arriving before 8 a.m. must remain outside and follow social distancing guidelines.
3. Tables will be set up outside on porch for temperature checks and hand sanitizer for students before entering the building.
4. All students, staff, and visitors must wear a face covering before entering the building. Students arriving without a face covering will be given one by the School.
5. All students, staff, and visitors must use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
6. If students are dropped off by parents, the student's temperature should be taken before they get out of the car.
7. For bus riders and walkers, their temperature will be taken before each student enters the building.
8. Before entering the School building, if a student's temperature is above 100.4 degrees, that student will be immediately isolated outside, and the Nurse will be notified. The Nurse will perform a quick checklist assessment. The student's parent will be notified to pickup their child. The child will remain outside, weather permitting.

Upon entering the building:

1. Students will grab breakfast, and go directly to their classroom, maintaining social distance and face coverings. One-way arrows on the floors will be used to direct hall traffic throughout the building.
2. Use of water fountains and water coolers will be limited. Students will be encouraged to bring their own water bottles. However, individual bottles of water will be available during breakfast and lunch upon request.
3. Trash bags and milk trays will be placed in each classroom, and will be set outside of each classroom after breakfast at the end of breakfast. Maintenance will be responsible for picking up trash bags and milk trays immediately when breakfast is over.
4. Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day in accordance with CDC guidelines.

Classes will start at 8:40 a.m.

Within The Classroom

1. All pods must be as static as possible.
2. Individual desks will be placed 6ft apart, to the maximum extent feasible. All desks will be facing in the same direction, to the maximum extent feasible.
3. Windows and doors will be open for ventilation.
4. Students will have their own individual supplies.
5. Sharing of items will be limited. Shared items will be disinfected at the end of each day.
6. Students will utilize individual cubbies.
7. Physical Ed/Health will take place in the classroom or outside whenever possible.
8. Teachers and/or Instructional Aides that must move from class to class, must adhere to schedules that are as static as possible (i.e., only be in one class per day/week.)
9. Backpacks are prohibited. School supplies will be provided by the school.
10. Parents are responsible for supplying headphones, earbuds, face coverings, and water bottles.

Lunch

1. Lunch will be provided in the classrooms, and will follow the same protocol as breakfast.

Bathroom Breaks

1. Students must use bathrooms one at a time. Students waiting to use the bathroom must maintain 6 feet of distance while waiting. Students must wear face coverings during this time and wash hands with soap and water after using the bathrooms.

Dismissal

1. Students will stay in the classroom until they are called.
2. Students must maintain 6 feet of distance when walking through hallways upon being called for dismissal.
3. Older walkers will be dismissed before younger walkers.
