Teachers and staff continue to prepare and administer the Smarter Balanced Assessments. The Smarter Balanced Testing is taking place in Wolcott from now until June 5th in Grades 3 through 8. Grade 11 Testing at the High School will be from until May 29<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure that students are well rested and prepared for this important assessment. We want everyone to put forward their best effort. Thank you.

Starting on June 29<sup>th</sup>, the Wolcott Summer Studies, one of the longest running programs in the State of Connecticut, will be conducting enrichment classes for students over the next five weeks.
