November

- I can echo short rhythmic and melodic phrases accurately.

December

- I can perform in a large group demonstrating proper concert etiquette.

January

- I can differentiate between the musical elements beat and rhythm.

February

- I can read and write basic rhythm notation using quarter note/rest, 2 eighth notes, half notes/rests and whole notes/rests.

March

- I can write multiple measures using previously learned rhythm notation and have the correct number of beats called for in the time signature.

April

- I can perform rhythmic phrases on classroom instruments.

May

- I can perform in a concert with my class demonstrating proper concert etiquette.
