- Students may not be permitted to perform in a concert if within the two weeks leading up to the concert, they are assigned ISS or OSS, missed five or more days of school, or have not shown adequate knowledge of the material being presented in the concert. Students who are dismissed from the performance are NOT exempt from the grade incurred, and must submit the makeup assignment given by Mrs. Brown.
- Students *must* be picked up from rehearsals on time and *must* have a ride home at the conclusion of concerts. Students who are picked up late (15 minutes or more) two times may no longer be allowed to stay for rehearsals or attend concerts for the duration of the semester, and may be given alternate assignments to complete. If a student is picked up late two times in first semester, they may be removed from the choral program for the remainder of the school year.
