Dear Bulldog Family,

Piedmont High School and Piedmont Middle School athletic event attendance will be restricted to 50% capacity for all home events. Tickets will only be sold on site for each event. Pre-sale of tickets at our schools will not take place this year.

Each paying attendee is highly encouraged to have exactly \$7 per person for varsity football games, \$5 per person for junior high football games, and \$5 per person for varsity/junior high volleyball games. Parking for varsity football games is \$5.

Per Governor Kay Ivey's Public Health Order, each attendee will be required to wear a face mask. Additionally, attendees must maintain a six foot distance between themselves and members of another household.

Attendance guidelines at away athletic events will be governed by the host school. Guidelines will be made public as soon as we receive them from the host school.

As we return to school and school sponsored activities, I would like to thank you for your patience and support as we continue to navigate the COVID-19 environment.
