COVID-19 Cases at Three Schools

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA - The Houston County School District has been notified of positive COVID-19 tests at three schools: Perry High, Perry Middle and Shirley Hills Elementary. As a safety precaution, the parents of students who may have been exposed to the virus were informed by their principal on August 8, 2020.

The school district continues to work closely with the Houston County Health Department, which investigates and conducts contact tracing. Due to privacy requirements, the names of the individual or details that may identify them cannot be released.

The safety of students and employees is the district's number one priority. Per current public health guidelines, those who were in close contact will remain off campus for 14 calendar days, unless advised otherwise by the Health Department. In keeping with district protocol, the areas will undergo deep cleaning and disinfecting prior to further use.
