As a fifth grader, we expect our students' classroom behavior to be top notch.

Classroom Rules and Expectations

- ✓ Be prepared.
- ✓ Always try your best.
- ✓ Respect yourself and others.
- ✓ Keep our classroom neat and clean.
- ✓ Listen and follow directions the first time.

In order to encourage appropriate behavior this year, we will use Class Dojo.

Positive Reinforcement

Students can earn Dojo points when they R.I.S.E. by showing respect, integrity, self-control, and effort. For every 25 Class Dojo points earned, they will receive a reward coupon. These coupons could be a homework pass, use special work supplies (pens, markers, etc.), extra device time, etc.

Consequences

If a student chooses not to follow rules, the following consequences may result:

- 1) Verbal Warning
- 2) Lose Class Dojo Points
- 3) After losing 5 Dojo points, a note will be sent home.
- 4) After losing 8 Dojo points, student will receive silent snack or silent lunch
- 5) After losing 9 Dojo points, a parent conference will be scheduled
- 6) After losing 10 Dojo points, student will receive an Office Referral

The following behaviors will not be given warnings before silent lunch/snack is assigned or an office referral is given:

- **Bullying**
- **Destroying Property**
- **Vulgarity/Profanity**
- **Fighting**
- **Disrespecting Authority**

**Dojo points will reset at the beginning of every nine weeks.
