Home Match Procedures

The following are the procedures we will be following at Bledsoe County High School for home volleyball games: Admission: \$5.00.

1. We ask that visiting teams do temperature checks before heading to Bledsoe.

(Visiting schools will be responsible for their own temperature checks of participating teams, coaches and their team party prior to leaving their campus to travel to their opponent's campus. The home team's administration or coach should verify with the visiting team's administration or coach that proper temperature checks have taken place. The home team shall not be responsible for conducting temperature checks of the visiting team party.)

2. All others (fans, officials, etc.) will have a temperature check before entering the game. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be admitted.

(At contests all coaches, players, team personnel, officials, administrators, and fans must have their temperatures checked before entering the facility. No one whose temperature measures 100.4 or greater may be admitted.)

- 3. Masks are required of anyone above the age of two unless they have an underlying medical condition. (Member schools will require that all fans wear facial coverings at all times while onsite (except children under age 2.)
 - 4. Doors will open one hour before the published starting time of the first match.
 - 5. Bleachers behind the benches and scorer's table will not be available for seating for the safety of the teams.
 - 6. Social distancing must be maintained at all times. This includes players on the bench, players during time outs, and other people who attend the match.
 - 7. Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available at all times.
 - 8. Locker rooms will not be in use during the matches.
 - 9. Masks/face coverings may be worn by coaches, players on the bench, and parent workers. That includes scorers, timers, trackers, and line judges.
 - 10. There will be no coin toss. Only head coaches will meet with officials prior to the match. The guest team will pick serve or receive and the home picks the bench. If there is no advantage to switching benches, teams will remain on the same bench throughout the match. If the match goes to a deciding set, the home team gets the choice of serve or receive.
 - 11. Prior to the match, entire teams will line up on the baseline and move straight forward to the attack line to greet the other team. No physical contact will be allowed. At the conclusion of the match, teams will return to the attack lines and congratulate the other team on their play.
 - 12. In the bleachers, family groups may sit together but social distancing must be maintained among all other guests.
 - 13. No water fountains will be operational. Players must provide their own water bottles.
 - 14. The gym must be emptied immediately following the conclusion of the matches.
