# GRADING SYSTEM (IHA)

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Students are to receive a grade of 100 for Term 4 for completing instructional packets or assignments from their teachers.



The grade of 100 will be averaged with grades from Terms 1-3 completed prior to Spring Break to determine the final average.



For all students, their cumulative or final grade will be an average of Semester 1 and Semester 2.



Honor status will be suspended for the Term 4.

# PROMOTION AND RETENTION OF STUDENTS (IHE)

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The District will only evaluate Grades 1-8 core content areas of English/ Language Arts and Mathematics for promotion.

State testing will not be required for promotion into the 4th Grade.

The promotion of high school students will be determined by course completion and Carnegie units.

# HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (IHF)

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Courses that students take must match their graduation pathway.



State testing will not be required for seniors who are eligible to graduate.
