

**Device Protection Program 2020-2021
Grades PreK-3**

Students in grades Prek-K will receive a district-issued iPad and students in grades 1-3 will receive a district-issued Chromebook to use throughout the school year. Students and their parent(s) and/or guardian(s) are required to electronically review and agree to the district's [Acceptable Use Policy](#) (this is typically done when you register your child for school), the [Student Device Guidelines and Procedures Handbook](#) and must complete the online [Student District Device Agreement](#). As with all school property, students and parents/guardians are responsible for any damage or loss. It is strongly recommended that students and parents/guardians participate in the Device Protection Program, especially remote learners who will have devices at home.

Cost: \$25 - Device insurance for all students for the 2020-2021 School Year, non-refundable.

Payments: Payments should be made online at www.mypaymentsplus.com. If you are unable to pay online, checks may be made payable to [Rocky Hill Public Schools](#) or exact cash is accepted. Payments made with check or cash must be in a sealed envelope. On the envelope, please write your child's name and grade, and the words "Chromebook INSURANCE". The envelope may be dropped off at the main office at school. Be sure to follow your school's visitation procedures. Checks may also be mailed to (do not mail cash):

Deadlines: Payments are due by November 2, 2020. *Please call your school principal if you require financial assistance.*

Coverage included in the Protection Program:

- ✓ Accidental Damage, including replacement. *If damage is intentional, the student and their parent(s) and/or guardian(s) will be responsible to pay for damages.*
- ✓ Theft, Robbery, Burglary (requires a filed police report within 24 hours of incident)
- ✓ Cracked Screens, Collisions, Drops, Falls & Missing keys
- ✓ Liquid Spills & Submersion
- ✓ Power surges
- ✓ Flood & Fire (requires police report)
- ✓ Vandalism not by student (requires a filed police report within 24 hours of incident)
- ✓ Receive an immediate replacement if device requires repair work included in coverage
- ✓ Manufacturer Warranty Coverage & Support
- Not included: lost devices, lost or damaged power adapters and cases, intentional damage/vandalism by student

Other important information: For Chromebooks, the district strongly encourages you to purchase a protective carry case or sleeve to fit a Dell 3100 Chromebook 11.6". A case or sleeve will help protect the Chromebook when placed in a backpack or carried to and from school. Cases may be purchased from a vendor of your choice such as Amazon, Dell, Walmart, etc.

If a student withdraws from Rocky Hill Public Schools and re-enrolls later in the same year, the protection purchased at the initial registration will be reinstated.
