

**Title I, Part A** provides supplemental resources to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families acquire the knowledge and skills in the state content standards and to meet the state student performance standards.

**Title II, Part A** is to increase student achievement through improving teacher and principal quality and increasing the number of certified/highly effective teachers in classrooms and highly qualified/effective principals in schools. **\*These funds were transferred to Title IA.**

**Title IV, Part A (SSAE)** - intent is to provide a well-rounded education to all students. Districts accepting these funds would address well-rounded educational opportunities, safe and healthy students and effective uses of technology. **\*These funds were transferred to Title IA.**
