


Reproduce on index paper. Color and cut out. Connect two strips together by overlapping at dotted areas at both ends.

Reproduce on construction paper. Color and cut out flowers. Cut along dotted lines on some flowers. Bend petals up slightly. Glue to windsock on small "x" areas. Cut strips of crepe paper (pink, yellow, green. etc.) and glue to bottom of windsock. Punch holes in windsock to string yarn. Hang from ceiling.
