15:00	Message - You're in Good Hands: Jesus Heals a Deaf Man Have you ever considered what it would be like to be deaf? How can an ancient miracle that happened 2,000 years ago, apply to 21st Century Christians? Spiritual deafness occurs when the static and background noise of our time deafens us to the voice of Jesus. Sometimes we also are spiritually tongue-tied when we should boldly speak up. There are many contemporary issues that face us to which we should not be deaf or mute. For all the times we have been deaf and silent, there is forgiveness in Christ. Our ears have heard the pounding of nails and the cry, "It is Finished." Our ears have been irrigated and washed of their sinful blockages in Holy Baptism. Our tongues have been loosened with the Bread and the Wine, Christ's very Body and Blood It's now time to boldly speak the Gospel of Christ in a world that is so often deaf to His voice.
