

CHAPTER 1.00 – PHILOSOPHY

SYSTEM LEGAL STATUS

1.12

The Barbour County School System derives its legal status from the State Legislature which, in turn, is subject to the Constitutions of both the State of Alabama and the United States. Amendment 111 to the Alabama Constitution provides that the legislature may by law provide for or authorize the establishment and operation of schools.

The Barbour County School System is, therefore, under the exclusive control and management of the Barbour County Board of Education as prescribed above, and shall be operated in accordance with constitutional and statutory law.

The corporate name of this school system shall be the Barbour County Board of Education, and it conducts its business at 100 Court Square, Courthouse, Clayton, Alabama 36016
