-REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING-

The Board President George Meyers called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., in the East Carter Co. R-II Elementary Cafeteria. -SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT-

Superintendent Richard Sullivan reported the electric bill was down \$611.79 from last year. The elementary sports banquet was held Monday night and went very well. MAP and EOC testing will begin soon. The District Secretaries went to lunch at Castello's for Secretaries Day; a good time was had by all. Calendar hearing was held. Sealed bus bids were opened by the Board President.
