
SPECIAL EDUCATION 101

WHAT IS SPECIAL EDUCATION?

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, special education is defined as: "Specially designed instruction to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability." Special education is in place to provide additional services, support, programs, specialized placements or environments to ensure that all students' educational needs are met.



INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM (IEP)

- · a detailed description of all special education services a student receives
- · a legal document meant to improve the student's educational experience
- · includes: current performance | goals | settings | testing modifications

COMMITTEE FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION (CSE)

- · responsible for ensuring the needs of all students with disabilities are met
- · receives referrals for special education services
- · arranges assessment for students to potentially receive services
- · reviews results of assessments
- · collaboratively creates and reviews a student's IEP
- consists of: the CSE chair/school representative | special education teachers | the students parents/guardians | regular education teachers | assessment experts
