5th & 6th Grade Language Arts

Fluency: Lyrics@Learn is our new fluency program. Students are required to listen/read a passage 3 times a day for 4 days a week and answer increasingly difficult questions as the days progress. This program has students reading an average of 20 minutes a day and is improving their oral reading fluency every second they spend reading!

Vocabulary: Students are required to spend 20 minutes every day on Moby Max Vocabulary. They are working on their own level and increasing their word capacity by at least 10 words a week!

<u>Reading</u>: This week we are focusing on how visual elements contribute to the understanding of text.

<u>5th Writing</u>: Students are learning the RACES strategy for writing to answer an informational prompt. We are focusing on writing a paragraph using this strategy for now; we will increase that to 3 paragraphs in 4 weeks!
