This week we will evaluate the characteristics of a planet as it relates to distance from the sun, size, composition and movement. Students will design and construct a relative scaled-model that can demonstrate the planet size in relationship to the Sun and Earth. The students can compare and contrast the physical characteristics of meteoroids, meteors, asteroids, and comets. Finally they will describe the effects of meteorites on the Earth's surface.

Standards: 5.ESS.1 - Cycles and patterns in the Solar System. The solar system includes the sun and all celestial bodies that orbit the sun. Each planet in the solar system has unique characteristics.
