Introduction

Campbell University was founded in 1887. The University occupies an 850-acre campus in the residential community of Buies Creek, NC, half-way between North Carolina's thriving metropolitan areas of Raleigh and Fayetteville. The region is one of the most progressive for education and research in the Southeast. Raleigh, the capital of North Carolina, and Fayetteville are each 30 miles away from campus. Within an hour of driving are the Research Triangle Park and the city of Durham.

Campbell offers more than 90 undergraduate tracks and concentrations. Students may declare a double major and a minor.

Academic Excellence

Students have opportunities for foreign study and independent study. 70% of the school majors entail internships.

There are 196 full time faculty members in the university, 90% of them have terminal degrees. Class size: 55% classes are less than 20 students, 27% of the classes have 20-39 students, 7% classes have 40-49 students.
