
Steps to completing the FCC application for the Emergency Broadband Program.

- 1. Visit https://getemergencybroadband.org/how-to-apply/ and scroll to the bottom of the page and click "Apply Now" to complete the online application.



 For the online application, fill in your information including your First Name, Last Name and choose your identification method and your home address. For the very last question about Do you qualify through your child, be sure to click Yes, I qualify through my child or dependent and then click NEXT.




3. Enter the information for your child/dependent that is a student in the Pulaski County School District. This will include the child's first name, last name and an identifier such as the last 4 digital of their social security number.







4. Choose a username, password and enter a contact email address. Click Next



5. Sign in to your account using the username/password that you created in step 4. Be sure to click the "I am not a robot" box and then click Sign In.



6. Once you have successfully signed in, you will need to choose "Get Started" under the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program



7. Select "Free and Reduced Price Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program in the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year" and then click Next.




8. You will then get a screen to confirm your information. If there are any mistakes, you can make corrections at that time. If not corrections are needed, check both boxes giving FCC permission to check information provided to them and then click submit.




9. The next question asks you if you share money with another adult already receiving the Emergency Broadband Benefit. The answer here should be NO unless someone in your home has already completed this process. The Emergency Broadband Program is only available 1 per household.




10. If you selected NO in step 9 then you will have additional questions appear. Select your answers and then click Next.




11. The next set of statements are agreements/understandings that you are acknowledging. You must initial the boxes as appropriate. Only initial box 1 if you live at a single address that has more than one household. Click Next.




12. You should get a screen that states the system could not automatically confirm your eligibility. Don't panic, you just have to enter the specific school information since you are qualifying under the District's participation in the Community Eligibility Provision. Select the "Free and Reduced Price Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program in the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year" again.



13. This will open up an additional question. Select "Select a USDA Community Eligibility Provision school. Click Next.




14. Select the appropriate information from the dropdown menus for state (KY), district and school. Click Next.



15. Initial the agreements and then click submit.



16. If the FCC can quickly confirm the information that you entered then you should see a screen that states that you Qualify. Toward the bottom of this screen will be a section specific to you that contains your FCC application number. Print the page, take a picture, or write down the information and store it in a safe place.



17. Final step: Contact your service provider and submit information to them including your FCC Application ID number if required to receive the benefit. For Windstream, you can complete the <u>online form</u> and then email it to the address listed on the form. For Spectrum, you will need to <u>login to your account</u> to access the form. For any other providers, you will need to contact them directly to find out how to complete the process.
