Course Name: Cabinet Making 1 & 2 Common Course Catalog Number: **171000**

Length of Course: **Semester** Pre-Requisite: **Introduction to woods**

Grade Level: 10-12

Course Description:

Students will be introduced to the hand tools; power tolls and machines used in rough carpentry and cabinetmaking. Students will select a project, which will be of the cabinet trade. Students are required to have a drawing or blueprint, bill of materials, and a plan of procedure. Student enrolled in both Cabinet Making One and Cabinet Making Two can carry larger projects over into Cabinet Making Two. Instructor must approve all projects before construction begins
