APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The meeting agenda was unanimously approved without objection.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 10, 2020 were unanimously approved as written without objection and signed by all members present.

SECTION 2 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Dr. Ruby Johnson provided information regarding

LEAP testing at the three schools:

- -Elementary school tested 290 of 297 students
- -Middle school tested 130-135 students, with 18 remaining untested
- -High school tested 50 of 55 students

Hybrid schedule to begin September 21 with the following counts

- -Elementary school 79 of 317 students
- -Middle school 44 of 152-153 students
- -High school 100 of 174 students

To date, only one teacher indicated underlying issues which caused a decision to deliver instruction off site virtually.

SECTION 4 - SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Sojourner provided the following:
- -Condolence to Mrs. Bonaparte in the loss of a family member
- -Extension of virtual instruction by another week, to begin on September 21 instead of September 14, with hybrid and virtual instruction
- -Lunches will be provided to persons under 18 years of age
- -SCSBA voting delegate and alternate had been selected and submitted. Mrs. Bonaparte will serve as the voting delegate with Mrs. Thompson serving as the alternate delegate.
- -Recent Bamberg County COVID activity still designated as high in all categories. Dr. Sojourner stressed that the district must be cognizant and report all incidents of known infection.
- -Request from Feed My Sheep Ministries to use the school facilities for its annual Thanksgiving lunch with the meals being prepared at the school for take outs to be delivered and some persons eating onsite or, possibly, with tables being set up outside the school for drive up delivery with no one eating in the facility, depending on the status of COVID incidence. Mrs. Goodman moved that permission be granted for the Ministry to prepare the Thanksgiving meal as outlined in the letter of request. Bishop Holman seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- -SCSBA's Risky Business seminar would be conducted virtually on October 15. Board members were asked to notify Mrs. Anderson if they wanted to be registered to participate.
- -Sanitizing of all of the old school buildings had been completed with the new facilities scheduled to be sanitized on September 15
- High school students, Jaela Tyler and Kalia Glover, were recipients of the Dr. Doretha Pressey Academic Scholarship receiving \$18,000 and \$12,000 respectively to be awarded over the course of four years.
- -Seven pieces of student art had been professionally framed and hung in the high school hallway and the elementary school office of the new school facility
- -Hotspots had been delivered to students and Verizon has indicated that difficulties should be minimized
- -Bob Damrom had made a bond deposit to help reduce the millage/tax rate for 2020-2021
- -New Chromebooks from USDA will soon be ready for students
- -Congressman Clyburn is working to get greater bandwidth in the area to help with virtual instruction. The report was received as information.

The motion was seconded by Mrs. Thompson and passed unanimously.
