



FLVS Guardian Catholic Parent Fact Sheet

Welcome! We are looking forward to another great year in the FLVS lab at Guardian. For 2019-2020, Students are registered for various classes including Elementary Spanish, Keyboarding, Algebra I, and Middle School Spanish. Guardian facilitators are working hard to support students as they learn and reach for excellence in the on-line world. Below are a few facts to help you, the Parent, support and encourage your child.

Student Expectations:

- Work Weekly (when school is in session) and follow the pace plan created in coordination with both the school facilitator and the FLVS instructor. On average, students should complete 6% or more each week of segment coursework.
- Homework – Weekly work not completed in the lab can be worked on at home if needed.
- Take advantage of open lab times in the morning and afternoon at school
- Encourage your student to utilize the handouts and note sheets provided by the facilitator. Guided notes are a terrific way for students to prepare for assessments and discussions with their teacher. Student notes can be used on most assessments. Not only does this practice encourage good study habit but can be the key to success.
- Encourage your student to work towards the best possible score on assignments. Many assignments can be resubmitted for a better grade. For written assignments, students should carefully read the instructors feedback found in the gradebook before resubmitting.
- Students should follow FLVS Academic Integrity Guidelines and submit their own work.
- The on-line course follows Guardian's school calendar. Students are expected to finish seg 1 before the holiday break and seg 2 before the summer break.

Communication:

- FLVS instructors will work closely with the school facilitators. Instructors may call in several times during the week to help students with course work and complete discussion-based assignments.
- Students are expected to do module Discussions called DBA's with their instructor. Students can plan on doing these in the classroom at various times during the semester.
- Progress information is sent to your facilitator weekly by the FLVS instruction.
- FLVS instructors may reach out monthly to parents via email, phone call, or text to provide updates on student progress. Working as a team, the facilitator, FLVS instructor, and Parent can help students reach their goals with great success.
