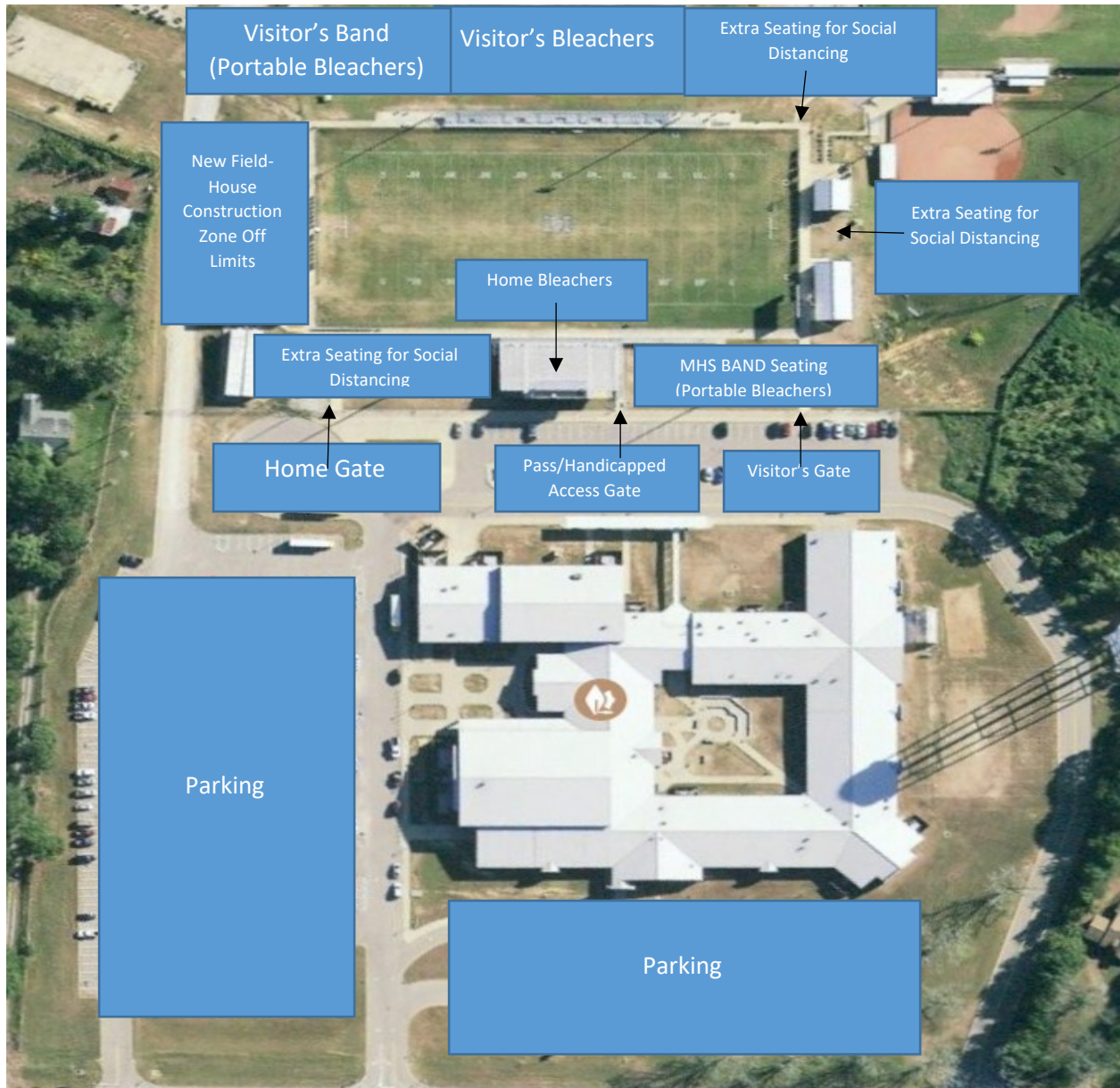


# Marbury High School Home Football Game Operational Plan



## Stadium Capacity and Entrance

- In order to meet the requirements by the Safer-at-Home Order from Governor Ivey, stadium seating capacity will be cut by at least 50%.
- **Seating** capacity at MHS is 2230. Therefore, a MAXIMUM of 1,000 tickets will be sold for football games.
- Tickets will be sold during the week of home games to limit the number of spectators purchasing tickets at the game. Both teams will be able to purchase tickets before

Friday night. Tickets will be sold at the gate. However, once 1000 tickets are sold, gates will be closed and no more tickets will be sold. We highly encourage spectators to buy tickets prior to Friday night.

- Home fans will enter through the gate to the left of the stadium. This gate is identified above with the title of “Home Gate.”
- Fans with disabilities, or fans that are on the “Pass List” will enter through the middle gate. This gate is identified above with the title of “Pass/Handicapped Access Gate.”
- Fans from the visiting team will enter through the gate to the right of the stadium. This gate is identified above with the title of “Visitor’s Gate.”

## Stadium Seating/Social Distancing/Assigned Locations for Bands/Cheerleaders

- All bleachers will have rows that will be closed to assist with social distancing.
- Tables, benches, and other seating arrangements will be distributed throughout the stadium to help with social distancing. These areas are to the left side of the home bleachers, in between the restrooms and concession stand, and along the right side of the visitor’s bleachers.
- Both teams’ bands will sit in portable bleachers to allow the band to sit together and to allow parents to be able properly practice social distancing in the bleachers.
- Both bands will have the opportunity to perform during halftime. Any needs that the visiting team’s band director have should be communicated through the Marbury High School Athletic Director, Coach Jimmy Lansdell.
- Bands will be expected to wear facial coverings while entering and exiting the stadium, as well as maintain social distancing inside the stadium if facial coverings are not worn during the game.

## Locker Rooms

- A new athletic field house is under construction. Therefore, Marbury High School will dress in the gym and the visiting team will use the baseball indoor facility.

## Sideline Access

- Anyone, outside of the players in uniform, who will need to be on the sideline will have to have a sideline pass. All passes will be delivered to the visiting team’s head coach the week of the game. Anyone that needs a sideline pass will need to email their request to Marbury High School’s Athletic Director, Jimmy Lansdell. ## Masks/Face Coverings

- When physical distancing cannot be maintained, facial coverings should be worn. Each person shall wear a mask, or other facial covering, that covers his or her nostrils and mouth at all times when within six feet of a person from another household. (Based on the July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Current Order of the State Health Officer).
- All fans will be expected to wear a facial covering during entrance and exit to the stadium, while visiting the concession stand, or visiting the restroom.
- While in the stadium seating area, individuals from different households should maintain a physical distancing of 6 feet.

## Concession Stand

- The MHS Football Booster Club will operate the concession stand. All volunteers must wear gloves and a mask.
- Food offerings may be limited to help minimize food contact by volunteers.
- Anyone waiting in line at the concession stand will be encouraged to practice social distancing.
