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INTERNET USAGE POLICY - STUDENT/PARENT

Internet Usage Policy applies to all students at Rock Point Community School who have access to computers and Internet to be used in the performance of their schoolwork. Use of the Internet by students at Rock Point Community School is permitted and encouraged where such use supports the goals and objectives of the education. Violation of these policies could result in disciplinary and/or legal action as outlined in the RPCS – Student Handbook. Students may also be held personally liable for damages caused by any violations of this policy. All students are required to acknowledge receipt and confirm that they have understood and agree to abide by the following rules. The use of the computers and the Internet are privileges, not a right.

Internet usage:

- 1. Students are expected to use the Internet (Hotspot) responsibly and productively. Internet (Hotspot) access to school-related activities only and personal use is not permitted.
- 2. School-related activities include research and educational applications that may be found via the Internet that would aide student learning.
- 3. All Internet data that is composed, transmitted and/or received by Rock Point Community School computer systems is considered to belong to Rock Point Community School and is recognized as part of its official data.
- 4. The equipment, services and technology used to access the Internet are the property of Rock Point Community School and reserves the right to monitor Internet traffic and monitor and access data that is composed, sent, or received through its online connection.
- 5. All sites and downloads may be monitored and/or blocked by Technology Department if they are deemed to be harmful and/or not productive to student learning.
- 6. The installation of software is strictly prohibited, without approval by Teacher, Principal and Technology Department (i.e. Online gaming, or other media application types).

The following is prohibited/not allowed:

- Sending or posting discriminatory, harassing, or threatening messages or images on the Internet or via Rock Point Community School's service. (Adheres to Student Handbook Anti-Bullying Policy).
- Use to perpetrate any form of fraud, and/or software, film, or music piracy.
- Stealing, using, or disclosing someone else's password without RPCS authorization. Hacking into unauthorized websites.
- Downloading, copying, or pirating software and electronic files that are copyrighted or without authorization.
- Sharing confidential material, trade secrets, or proprietary information outside of RPCS organization.
- Sending or posting chain letters, solicitations, or advertisements not related to school purposes or activities.
- Introducing malicious or trojans software onto the company network and/or jeopardizing the security of the organization's electronic communications systems.
- If a student is unsure about what constituted acceptable Internet usage, then he/she should ask his/her overseer for further guidance and clarification.
- Rock Point Community School has a wide variety of technology devices available for student usage. Such devices include but not limited to:
