The Jefferson County School District is participating in a Special Assistance Program for the Lunch and Breakfast Programs for the current school year . If your children) attend school in grades Pre-Kindergarten – 12th, their lunch and breakfast will be available at no charge to them. Any student enrolled at either school site may participate in lunch and breakfast without a charge.

The Special Assistance Program is being provided to help promote sound nutrition and *Dietary Guidelines*. However, the concept of healthy school meals encompasses more than just meeting dietary guidelines, it also means making safe nutritious meals accessible to all children. Good nutritional meals consumed at school ensure happy and well-adjusted children in the classroom. Our schools need your parental support in accomplishing successful food programs for our children.

All meals served will meet patterns established by the U. S. Department of Agriculture. However, if a child has been determined by a doctor to be disabled and the disability would prevent the child from eating the regular school meals, this district/school will make any substitutions prescribed by the doctor. If a substitution is needed, there will be no extra charge.
