


The School

Stone Memorial High School is a comprehensive, 4-year high school with a current enrollment of 1,084 students in grades nine through twelve. U.S. News & World Report awarded Stone Memorial the Silver Award among the nation's best high schools. The academic program is organized on a block schedule, where the maximum load is 9 credits per year. Our high school has gained accreditation from the Tennessee State Board of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Various booster organizations and PTSO are active groups that provide support through voluntary efforts and fiscal contributions, which enhance instruction, and student support.
