



## Content Editor: Embedded Maps

### Content Editor: Embedded Maps

Using the HTML button within your Content editor, you can embed interactive maps right into your page. The following instructions will guide you through adding a map from Google Map services wherever your website provides the content editor option.

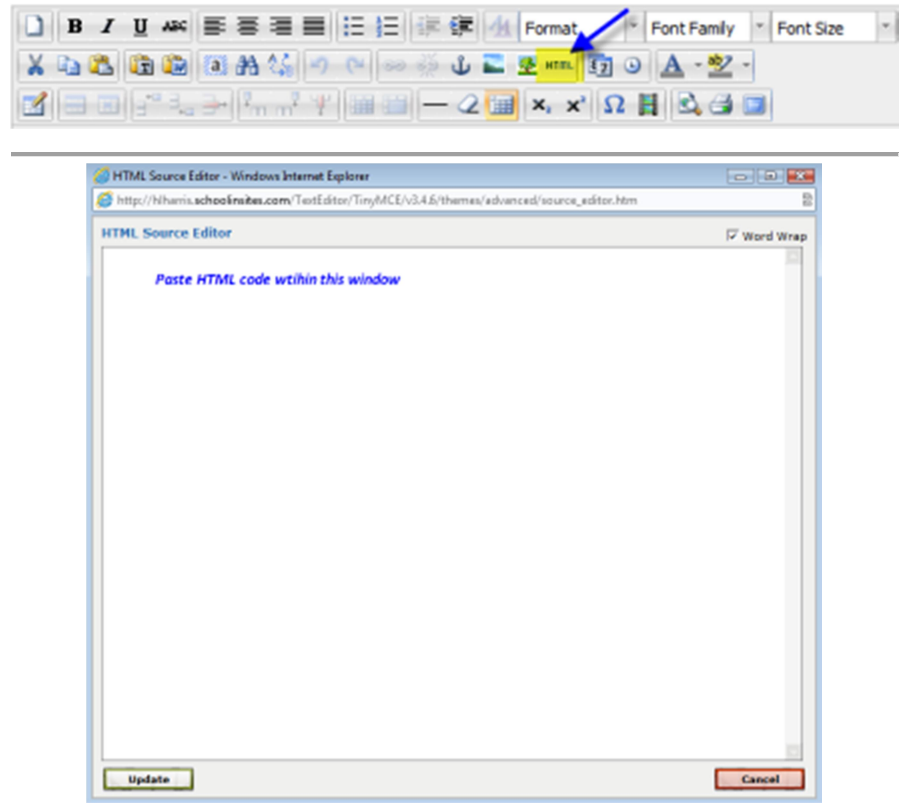
To obtain HTML Code for Map:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to <a href="http://www.google.com/maps">http://www.google.com/maps</a></li> <li>Type in address for map</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the 'Link' option. Click to expand two options.</li> <li>Select the "Paste HTML to embed in website" option by clicking once in this field. Be sure entire code is selected.</li> <li>Right-click and choose "copy" from menu</li> </ul> <p><i>You now have the code for the map</i></p>	

To embed Map into your Content editor

- Login to your Website
- Navigate to content editor of desired page where you wish Map to be displayed. Place your cursor inside editor area where you wish to embed map.
- Then, click on the HTML button from the editor tools
- From resulting window, *Paste* code into the HTML Source Editor and select *Update* button to save

*You can Paste by CTRL V or by Right Click-Paste*



Once you have inserted the HTML within the Source Editor and clicked Update, be sure to Save the information to the actual Page the editor is located. Now, you are ready to view the embedded map on your public website!
