

Dear Parents/Guardians:

On Friday, October 12, Facts/RenWeb launched a new websiterebranding the RenWeb company to the FACTS name.

What does this mean for you?

- * The way you log into your accounts will not change (whether in ParentsWeb or on the RenWeb Home app). Your usernames and passwords will remain the same.
- * If you currently go to RenWeb.com to access ParentsWeb, you will be able to continue doing so for a time, but you'll want to start making the switch and logging in at FACTSMgt.com.
- * There are additional login instructions on the Parent Resources sheet that FACTS provided. It's available here.

The name ParentsWeb will be changing to FACTS Family Online. However, you will still login using the same credentials at FACTSMgt.com and you will still use it the same way once you've logged in.



Own the Avenue


