

Principal's Points

Dear Parents & Guardians:

Thank you to all the families who joined us at Mass this past weekend. It was wonderful to see so many children in uniform. Those who came in uniform were able to have free dress on Monday. For our new families, I want to take this opportunity to talk about our children's envelope program. In today's society, our children receive many messages that tell them how to live their lives and sometimes the messages are not all positive. We would like to bring a different message to our children - a message of stewardship. We want them to know that God has given them gifts and that they each have something to share with others. For this reason, we provide children's offertory envelopes to allow them to place their gifts in the offertory basket each week. This is not about raising money. This is to teach the children the idea of giving back for all that God has given them. As children prepare their envelope each week, they should write down how they gave of their time or talent to help others. Children should also be instructed in the idea of giving 10% of their treasure.

Each week, during the Preparation of the Altar and Gifts at the Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses, children will be invited to come to the altar to place their envelope in a basket. If a child is uncomfortable coming to the altar, he or she may also place the envelope in the baskets that are passed through the congregation. We ask you to support the effort by first and foremost bringing your children to Mass every weekend. Remind them to bring their envelopes with them and talk with them regarding their time, talents, and treasures. Please do not just give children money for their envelope. Children will be proud to contribute a portion of their own allowance or earnings from doing chores at home. For older children, it could be from money they earn from jobs like babysitting or mowing lawns. Each student will receive a new box of envelopes by tomorrow to bring home.





Tryouts for girls jv and varsity volleyball and coed varsity soccer were this week. The teams have been chosen and they'll start preparing for the games and matches that start the week of September 4.

Girls volleyball season runs from August 13-October 5. Mr and Mrs Sava are returning to coach varsity volleyball and Mr Pistone will be coaching JV volleyball.

Coed soccer season runs from August 13-October 12. Coach Riker is returning to coach the team this year.

All students that participate in St Stephen athletics must complete and turn in to the office the four Diocesan and school required sports forms before being eligible to play. The sports forms are available on the school website under athletics. The sports forms must be completed each school year, including the physicals.

The sports fee is \$65 for girls volleyball and coed soccer.


Student athletes have their eligibility checked every Monday during the season. Student athletes must maintain a 70 or above to stay eligible to practice and/or play in games. Please see the parent student handbook for the complete eligibility policy.

St Stephen participates in the Hillsborough Catholic Youth Sports League (HCYSL) with nine other Catholic schools from the county. Girls sports are volleyball, basketball, flag football, and track and the boys sports are coed soccer, track, basketball, and flag football. The sports seasons schedule for the league and St Stephen is available on the school website under athletics.
