I want to thank every parent and parish member who put in their time to volunteer to make this event such a success. I am grateful for every one of you.



Girls Basketball: The Mustang girls basketball teams played last Thursday against Christ the King. The varsity won an exciting game 33-31, and were led in scoring by Hannah Grace W. 10 points, Noelle H. 9 points, and Tabitha V. 8 points. The JV played well but lost 14-10. The varsity beat Corpus Christi 37-17, and were led in scoring by Hannah Grace W. 14 points and Noelle H. 11 points. Both teams played great on Tuesday and beat Nativity. The varsity won 31-10, and Hannah Grace W. and Tabitha V. both scored 10 points to lead the Mustangs. The JV won 16-8, and were led in scoring by Sophia C., Vivian G., and Dani J. all with 4 points. The varsity played St. Joseph vesterday and won 41-26. They were led in scoring by Hannah Grace W. 17 points and Noelle H. and Tabitha V. 9 points each. There are no games scheduled the week we return from Thanksgiving break.

Boys Track: The boys track team had their first running, relay, and high jump meet Saturday at Jesuit and all of the Mustang runners did a great job. The varsity finished 5th and the JV 6th overall. Here are the results for the Mustang



runners that placed in the top 8 and earned points for the team.

The first field event meet-discus, shot put, and long jump is today at Christ the King at 4:00. Only the boys participating in those events have to attend. The team has a busy week when we return from Thanksgiving break. The cross country meet is Tuesday, November 27 here on the St. Stephen campus at 4:00.
