Dear Parents/Guardians:

I'm leaving this information here for one more week to be sure everyone has seen it. On Friday, **October 12, Facts/RenWeb launched a new website** rebranding the RenWeb company to the FACTS name.

What does this mean for you?

* The way you log into your accounts will not change (whether in ParentsWeb or on the RenWeb Home app). Your usernames and passwords will remain the same.

* If you currently go to RenWeb.com to access ParentsWeb, you will be able to continue doing so for a time, but you'll want to start making the switch and logging in at <u>FACTSMgt.com</u>.

* There are additional login instructions on the Parent **Resources** sheet that FACTS provided. It's available <u>here</u>.

The name ParentsWeb will be changing to FACTS Family Online. However, you will still login using the same credentials at FACTSMgt.com and you will still use it the same way once you've logged in. If Thursday folders go home please remember to return them to the school the next day

The Day of the Dead is a Mexican Holiday that celebrates family members who have died.

To connect with our Catholic traditions on All Hallow's Eve (Halloween), All Saints Day and All Souls Day; we would like to encourage students to bring in pictures of loved ones who have died for display on our school shrine.

If you choose to participate, please make sure that the picture is labeled with the student's name and grade so we can return it to them. Each student can bring in ONE picture, or collage of pictures, up to 8.5x11. Please do not send in 'original', 'valuable' or 'one of a kind' pictures that could get lost or damaged. Copies of photographs are fine. The photo submissions will be taped to paper and hung on the wall. We will make a good-faith effort to return your photos safely and with minimal damage (rips, folds, tape marks, etc.) in Thursday folders the following week.

You may also send in artificial flowers or LED battery-powered tea lights that can be displayed with our shrine. These may not make it back to you since they will be hard to label and keep track of. There will also not be open flames (candles) allowed or live flowers (water could be spilled or splashed on pictures)

Pictures will be on display starting on Halloween (Wednesday, 10/31/18) for one week. We will say special prayers for these deceased loved ones during technology and world languages classes.

I hope you and your children have a safe and happy All Saints Day season and this event will add to your family traditions.

Original Works Art Fundraiser


