Principal's Points

Dear Parents & Guardians:

The safety of your children is as important to us as we know it is to you. Electronic devices and the Internet can be tools that assist with education and at the same time they can have a negative influence on the lives of children. One negative influence is pornography. Pornography is a virus infecting the minds and hearts of adults and children in our society and more people are exposed to it than ever before. Protecting our children from pornography is a Catholic responsibility that we must attend to with urgency. In 2009, Michael Leahy released results of a survey of 29,000 individuals at North American universities 51% of male students and 32% of female students first viewed pornography before their teenage years (12 and younger). You may be thinking, "My fourth grader isn't looking for porn." Sadly, the porn industry is looking for your fourth grader. Scientific research on the brain reveals exposure to pornography has long term, harmful effects to our society through abuse, broken families and damaged relationships.

The Diocese of St. Petersburg has provided workshops to teachers, administration, staff, and parents in partnership with Covenant Eyes, an Internet Accountability and Filtering Software Company, to teach them about safeguarding family's technology against unrestricted access explicit material. If you have a student who is in 4th grade or older, please consider texting the word 'secure' to 66866. 
