

Principal's Points

Dear Parents & Guardians:

Next week students in grades 2-8 will take the lowa Assessment. This assessment provides standardized test information for measuring student achievement and growth. It allows us to compare ourselves to other students in Florida and in the nation and helps us make informed decisions about students and curriculum. This is just one assessment, along with iReady testing and classroom assessments, that allows us to track student progress.

How can you help get your child ready for test day? Be sure they get a good night's sleep, eat a healthy breakfast, and arrive to school on time. Any student in grades 2-8 arriving late on a test day will remain in the front office until testing time is over for that day. Test time typically ends at approximately 10 a.m. each day. This will also mean that they will miss instructional time to make up their test.

I would also like to take this time to remind everyone of the importance of coming to school on time. On time does not mean 7:59, it means being in the classroom between 7:40 - 7:50 a.m. This allows students time to catch up with their friends and prepare themselves for the day. When students arrive late to class it is a disruption to those in the room and makes for a rushed start to the day. If your child is habitually arriving to school late, I will be setting up conferences to discuss strategies to help you get the children to school on time.


