As you may be aware, the parish is hoping to complete the sale of the old church property on Bell Shoals Road as quickly as possible so that we can focus our attention on growing in our new home. As part of this process, a meeting was recently held to discuss the rezoning efforts of the this property. There is a small, but vocal group that is opposed to the development of the property that is negatively influencing the county zoning and planning staff. The Development Team requests your immediate action to help our commissioners decide on the rezoning proposal. Please call or email the four staff members listed below with your statement of support today. Include in your statement something about how the proposed development:

- Is a good use of the property
- Serves a need in the community
- Allows seniors to stay in an area they have lived in for years
- Is designed to be compatible with the surrounding communities
- As a residential community will not likely have a significant impact on the traffic issues already experienced on Bell Shoals Road

The planning staff is compiling all the recommendation reports and testimonials, and it would be to our benefit if the staff members had some positive feedback regarding this proposed development to consider in advance of their decision.
