Summer Reading Project Activities

Choose one of the following projects to complete with your assigned reading this summer. Projects are due the first week of school.

Character Analysis Google Slides or Power Point	<p>Time to meet the characters you love (or love to hate), and slides/ppt is the tool to help you do it!</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Your project must include analysis of 3 characters in your novel.● Each analysis must include: character's name, three character traits with proof from the text, picture (use descriptions from the book to find a picture to match what the character could look like), how the character changed throughout the book and your feelings towards the character. Use text evidence to support your thoughts.● Project must be colorful and easy to follow.
Scrapbook	<p>Create a scrapbook as if the main character put it together.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Cover must include the character's name.● Include journal entry from the main character's point of view that gives a summary of the book.● Include a letter written from the main character's point of view to a secondary character describing the main problem that the character faces in the story. Include a letter from the secondary character's point of view in response, describing the solution to the main character's problem as it happened in the story.● Include pictures and photographs to illustrate the main characters, main events, and the setting. Place the pictures throughout the scrapbook with captions that describe what is shown in each.
Biography	<p>A biography is a written account of the series of events that make up a person's life. The biography explains how those events shaped the person they have become. Write a biography about the main character in the book, describing how these important life events have changed and molded the character into the person at the end of the story.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Cover must include the title of your biography, author's name, and character's name.● Include the following about the character: Important dates, Family information, Lifetime accomplishments, Major life events, Effects/impact on society, Explanation of how life events influenced who the person has become.● Each of the above requirements should each have a section in the biography
