#### **Child Find**

All children with disabilities residing in the State, including children with disabilities attending private schools, regardless of the severity of their disability who are in need of special education and related services are identified, located, and evaluated. The collection and use of data to meet the requirements of Child Find will be subject to the confidentiality requirements.

#### **Initial Evaluation Procedures**

Once a child is referred, the Multidisciplinary
Evaluation Team (MET) chairperson and
the team including the parent meet
to discuss and review the information
gathered to determine if further evaluation
is needed. The parent or legal guardian
must give written permission for a
comprehensive assessment.
Once parental permission is obtained,
the school district has 60 days to
complete the assessment and
make an eligibility determination.
